#### **ABOUT THE COURSE**

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work.

The unit requires the student to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies

It is a mandatory workplace health and safety compliance requirement that all persons who enter a Construction Site, for reasons including but not limited to, the purpose of manual work or supervision, have completed their General Construction Induction Training (GCIT) and hold a GCIT Card, commonly referred to as a White Card\*.

\*Important to note: Academia do not award a GCIT Card upon successful course completion. Students will receive a "Statement of Attainment" outlining successful completion of the Nationally Recognised unit of competency.
